



Program Terms and Conditions

The **Buy More. Get More.** program ("Program") is a Reward program offered by Vista Professional Outdoor Lighting ("Vista," "we," "us," or "our") to eligible professional trade contractors in the United States and Canada.

By submitting a Reward request, you agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. Please read them carefully.

SECTION 01

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Program provides Reward payments to eligible contractors who purchase qualifying Vista Residential products from authorized Vista distributors on a single invoice within the Program Window. Reward amounts are determined by a tiered structure based on the net total of the qualifying invoice, as set forth in Section 03 below.

SECTION 02

ELIGIBILITY

The Program is open exclusively to **professional trade contractors** operating as verifiable businesses in the outdoor lighting, landscape, landscape lighting, electrical, or related trades, located in the United States or Canada.

To be eligible, a participant must:

1. Be at least 18 years of age.
2. Operate as a verifiable business in the trade, including but not limited to landscape contractors, landscape lighting contractors, electrical contractors, and other professional outdoor lighting installers.
3. Purchase qualifying Vista Residential products through an authorized Vista distributor.
4. Submit Reward requests in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.

Homeowners, retail buyers, DIY purchasers, and non-trade individuals are not eligible to participate. Vista reserves the right to verify trade status and to deny submissions from non-qualifying participants.

Employees, officers, and immediate family members of Vista Professional Outdoor Lighting, its parent company, affiliates, subsidiaries, and authorized distributors are not eligible to participate.



SECTION 03

PROGRAM WINDOW AND REWARD TIERS



Program Window: May 15, 2026 through July 31, 2026 (the "Program Window"). To qualify for a Reward, the qualifying invoice must be dated within the Program Window.

Submission Deadline: All Reward requests must be received by Vista no later than 11:59 p.m. Pacific Time on Friday, August 14, 2026. Submissions received after the deadline will not be processed.

Reward Tiers. Reward amounts are determined by the net total of a single qualifying invoice, as follows:

SINGLE INVOICE NET TOTAL	REWARD AMOUNT
\$1,000 – \$2,499	\$100
\$2,500 – \$4,999	\$325
\$5,000 – \$7,499	\$700
\$7,500 – \$9,999	\$1,100
\$10,000 or more	\$1,500

Customer Cap. The maximum total Reward payable to any single eligible contractor across the Program Window is **\$3,000**, regardless of the number of submissions or total spend.

Per-Invoice Qualification. Each qualifying invoice is evaluated independently against the tier table above. Multiple invoices may not be combined or aggregated for the purpose of qualifying for a higher Reward tier. There is no limit to the number of separate qualifying invoices a contractor may submit, subject to the Customer Cap.

SECTION 04

QUALIFYING PRODUCTS

Eligible: All Vista Residential fixtures, transformers, controls, and accessories purchased through an authorized Vista distributor.

Not Eligible: Vista Commercial / Architectural Division products, non-Vista products, freight charges, shipping fees, sales taxes, and any installation labor or service fees included on the invoice. Non-eligible items will be deducted from the invoice net total when calculating Reward tier qualification.

Vista reserves the right to add, remove, or modify the list of eligible products at any time. The current list of eligible products is determined by Vista in its sole discretion based on Vista’s published Residential Division product catalog as of the invoice date.

SECTION 05

QUALIFYING PRODUCTS

To request a Reward, an eligible contractor must submit the following via email to **promotions@vistapro.com**:





1. **Subject line:** "Buy More. Get More. Submission, [Business Name]"
2. **Attached invoice:** A JPG, PNG, or PDF image of the original dated invoice from an authorized Vista distributor. The invoice must clearly show the contractor's name and business, the distributor name and branch, product SKUs and descriptions, quantity purchased, net total paid, and transaction date.
3. **Email body must include:** business name, contact name, mailing address, email address, phone number, the distributor branch where the purchase was made, and the number of invoices attached to the submission.

Acceptable proof of purchase is limited to original dated invoices issued by an authorized Vista distributor at the point of sale. **Distributor purchase-history printouts, account statements, and reproductions of original invoices** are not acceptable and will not be processed.

Vista is not responsible for submissions that are lost, late, misdirected, incomplete, or that fail to meet the requirements set forth in these Terms and Conditions. The contractor is responsible for ensuring the submission email is delivered to and received by Vista before the Submission Deadline.

SECTION 06

QUALIFYING PRODUCTS

Acknowledgment. Contractors will receive an automated confirmation within 24 hours of successful delivery of the submission email to promotions@vistapro.com. This automated confirmation acknowledges receipt only and does not constitute approval of the submission.

Processing. Vista will review each submission for compliance with these Terms and Conditions and will provide a processing confirmation within five (5) business days of receipt indicating whether the submission has been accepted, rejected, or requires additional information.

Reward Delivery. Approved Rewards will be delivered as a digital Visa or Mastercard prepaid gift card, emailed to the email address provided in the contractor's submission, within six (6) weeks of submission approval. All terms and conditions of the prepaid card issuer apply. Visa and Mastercard are registered trademarks of their respective companies.

Rejected Submissions. A submission may be rejected for reasons including but not limited to: missing or incomplete information, ineligible products, ineligible participant, invoice dated outside the Program Window, late submission, fraudulent or altered documentation, or duplicate submission. If a submission is rejected, the contractor will receive an email explaining the reason. Contractors may resubmit a corrected submission provided the Submission Deadline has not passed.

SECTION 07

AUDIT AND VERIFICATION RIGHTS

Vista reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to audit, investigate, and verify any submission, including but not limited to:

1. Requesting additional documentation to verify the authenticity of the submitted invoice, including but not limited to confirmation directly from the issuing distributor.
2. Verifying the contractor's trade status, business operations, and eligibility to participate in the Program.





3. Verifying that submitted products were actually purchased and not subsequently returned, refunded, or credited.

Participation in the Program constitutes the contractor's agreement to cooperate fully with any such audit or verification request. Failure to cooperate with a verification request, or the submission of fraudulent, altered, or otherwise non-compliant documentation, will result in immediate disqualification and forfeiture of any pending or paid Rewards. Vista further reserves the right to pursue any legal or equitable remedy available under applicable law.

SECTION 08

PROGRAM MODIFICATION AND TERMINATION

Vista reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to modify, suspend, or terminate the Program, or to change these Terms and Conditions, at any time and without prior notice. Any such modification, suspension, or termination will not affect Reward submissions properly received and approved before the effective date of the change. The version of these Terms and Conditions in effect at the time a submission is received will govern that submission.

Vista further reserves the right to disqualify any participant who, in Vista's sole judgment, has violated these Terms and Conditions, attempted to circumvent the Program, or engaged in fraudulent, deceptive, or otherwise inappropriate conduct in connection with the Program.

SECTION 09

USE OF INFORMATION

Information submitted by participants in connection with the Program, including business name, contact information, and invoice details, will be used by Vista to administer the Program, process Reward payments, communicate with participants, verify submissions, and improve Vista's products and services. Vista may share submitted information with its authorized distributors, prepaid card issuers, and service providers solely as necessary to administer the Program and deliver Rewards.

All submitted proofs of purchase become the property of Vista and will not be returned. By submitting, the participant agrees to Vista's use of the information described in this Section.

SECTION 10

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

To the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, Vista, its parent, affiliates, subsidiaries, officers, directors, employees, agents, and authorized distributors shall not be liable for any indirect, incidental, consequential, special, exemplary, or punitive damages arising out of or in connection with the Program, including but not limited to lost profits, lost business opportunity, loss of data, or loss of goodwill, whether based in contract, tort, strict liability, or any other legal theory, even if Vista has been advised of the possibility of such damages.

Vista's total cumulative liability to any single participant in connection with the Program shall not exceed the total Reward amount payable to that participant under these Terms and Conditions, capped at \$3,000.

Vista is not responsible for any technical malfunctions, lost or delayed emails, network or server



errors, or other technical problems that may interfere with a contractor's ability to submit or receive communications relating to the Program.



SECTION 11

GOVERNING LAW AND DISPUTE RESOLUTION

These Terms and Conditions, and any dispute arising out of or relating to the Program or these Terms, shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of California, without regard to its conflict-of-laws principles.

Any dispute, claim, or controversy arising out of or relating to the Program or these Terms and Conditions shall be brought exclusively in the state or federal courts located in Ventura County, California, and the parties consent to the personal jurisdiction of such courts. The participant waives any objection based on inconvenient forum.

The Program is intended to comply with all applicable federal, state, provincial, and local laws and regulations. Where any provision of these Terms and Conditions conflicts with applicable law, the provision shall be modified to the minimum extent necessary to comply with such law, and the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.
